You can meet Santa at the mall or at City Hall Plaza, or you could catch him performing with the Boston Pops. Or on Tuesday, Dec. 13, you can see him in an apron rolling burritos in Brookline.

Santa Claus will join Christmas in the City — a local organization that hosts an annual holiday party for more than 3,000 homeless youths — for a day of cheesy burrito-making fun at the Anna's Taqueria location on Harvard Street in Packard's Corner. For \$10, guests

get a burrito of their choice, rolled personally by Kris Kringle (or a Christmas in the City volunteer), as well as an order of chips and salsa. One-hundred percent of all proceeds raised during the burrito-a-thon will go toward Christmas in the City's Dec. 18th shindig.

This isn't the first time Anna's has joined forces with a worthy local cause — having hosted Boston Marathon survivor Adrienne Haslet-Davis for Limbs for Life back in April, and now defunct Bos-
